

Student Code of Conduct & School Policies

1. Attendance Guidelines

- Students must attend school regularly and arrive on time.
 - A minimum attendance percentage, as prescribed by the school, must be maintained.
 - Late arrivals and early departures require prior written permission.
 - Absence due to illness must be supported with a medical note.
